NOTIFICATION

Revised date of the Summit on Biodiversity - 30 September 2020

Dear Madam/Sir,

Further to notification <u>2020-034</u>, I am pleased to inform you that, pursuant to decision 74/562 of the General Assembly, the Summit on Biodiversity will now be held on **30 September 2020**.

As noted in the earlier notification, and as set out in Resolution 74/269 of the General Assembly, the Summit on Biodiversity will be convened during the high-level week of the seventy-fifth session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) under the theme "Urgent Action on Biodiversity for Sustainable Development". It will consist of an opening segment, a plenary segment for general discussions, two Leaders' Dialogues and a closing segment. The Leaders' Dialogues will be held under the following themes: "Addressing biodiversity loss and mainstreaming biodiversity for sustainable development" (Dialogue 1) and "Harnessing science, technology and innovation, capacity-building, access and benefit sharing, financing and partnerships for biodiversity" (Dialogue 2). Further details concerning the scope, modalities, format and organization of the Summit are outlined in paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 of Resolution 74/269. However, decision 74/562 provides for submission of pre-recorded statements by Heads of State or Government and other leaders of delegation.

As was also noted in the previous notification, further to Resolution 74/269, the Summit will provide a unique opportunity to demonstrate ambition to accelerate action on biodiversity for sustainable development. It will thereby give momentum to the development and eventual adoption of an effective post-2020 global biodiversity framework at the fifteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention.

In view of the above, I encourage Parties to participate in the Summit at the highest possible level.
